CELEBRATING CREATION- "STARS" Psalm 8. 1-4

We believe that God has created all things, and in him all things hold together. 'Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made'. John 1 verse 3.

God is Almighty

Question - How almighty is God? Can we even imagine his power?

1. The Sun – our nearest star- ¹⁴ Then God said, "Let there be lights in the sky. These lights will separate the days from the nights. They will be used for signs to show when special meetings begin and to show the days and years. 15 They will be in the sky to shine light on the earth." And it happened. Genesis 1:14-15

Everything that grows needs the light and heat that our very own star, the sun, gives us every day. God made the stars to make life possible. "Thus says the LORD, Who gives the sun for light by day and the fixed order of the moon and the **stars** for light by night, Who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar; The LORD of hosts is His name." (Jeremiah 31:35)

God makes the sun shine through gravity and tiny particles! – forcing them together to make light and heat. '3 And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light'. This is how he did it!

The sun is very big, but it is only a young adult!

³Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. 5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. John 1.3-5

<u>Prayer - Thank you Almighty God</u> for the gift of food. All life and living is only possible because you first created our very own star, the sun.

- 2. How Many Stars are there?- ³ I look at the heavens you made with your hands. I see the moon and the stars you created. ⁴And I wonder, "Why are people so important to you? Prayer - Thank you extravagant God that you have created so much, so many stars and so many galaxies to put the stars in! Thank you for their beauty. You are amazing!
- 3. How Near are the Stars?- How close are we to the other stars? Space is very, almost unimaginably big. Jeremiah 23:24 states, "Do I not fill heaven and earth? declares the Lord." God exists across the universe. He is universal. He is everywhere.

Psalm 139:7-10 describes God's presence throughout creation: "Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence?

We are so small compared to all that God has created, and so weak and powerless compared to God Almighty, and yet we are chosen and loved by God.

Question - Can our weakness be a strength? Jeremiah 31:3: "I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore I have continued my faithfulness to you"

Question - Knowing the scale of the universe, how big it is, how does that make you feel?

Prayer - Thank you Loving God that I know you are, and always will be, with me wherever I am.
