Colossians 1.15-19



Jesus Christ is the One LORD

We all have experience in filling in forms and are often asked what our preferred title is. You can find these on many a drop-down menu: Mr, Mrs, Miss, Ms, Mx, Dr, Rev, Prof, Sir, Dame, Other. Our preferred title says something about us. This could be marital status or an honoured or earnt position.

Our journey through the Nicene Creed brings us this week to Jesus and begins with His titles. The first thing said is

that He is **'One Lord'.** The repetition of 'One' takes us back to the fourth word of our Creed where this word comes before 'God'. Both the use of 'One' and 'Lord' leave us in no doubt that Jesus is God. 'Lord' is used in Judaism to talk about God and, when in capitals in English as 'LORD', it refers to the sacred, revealed name of God as *Yahweh*. The title 'Lord' also sets Jesus in His rightful place as the One who is in authority, to whom we submit and worship.

After these titles comes the name - Jesus.

This is a derivative of Joshua, which means 'saving one'. So even His given name is rich in meaning. 'Christ' is not His surname. This again is a title which means 'Anointed One' or 'Anointed of God'. In Hebrew this word would be rendered 'Messiah'.

The next part of the Creed unpacks what 'One Lord' and 'Christ' mean. He is the only Son of God. There is no other. He came from the Father and has been there for all eternity. He always was and is and will be. He is God from God. And just as God is light, so is Jesus. He even referred to himself twice as being so when He said: "I am the Light of the World" (John 8.12 and 9.5). If these statements are not clear enough, we are told that Jesus is true God, begotten, not created by God. He is One Being with the Father, who was there at the beginning of creation, when everything was made through Him. After all, in Genesis 1, God creates by speaking. It was by His words that everything came into being. John's Gospel begins by making this explicit when he starts by saying: "In the beginning was the Word. The Word was

with God and the Word was God" (John 1.1). Jesus is the Word of God and is God. He shares all the characteristics of God, because He is God.

STOP! We have been bombarded with statements about Jesus, starting with His titles. We need to pause to wonder. Which one of these titles means the most to me at the moment? What new fact about Jesus have I learnt? And all this comes before we have even got on to how He saves us! So reflect and then get lost in wonder, love and praise of Jesus. You might like to use Colossians 1. 15-19 to add more to your worship.
